The clients included are only those who were represented under Legal Aid funding; we do not currently have statistics for non Legal Aid funded clients.

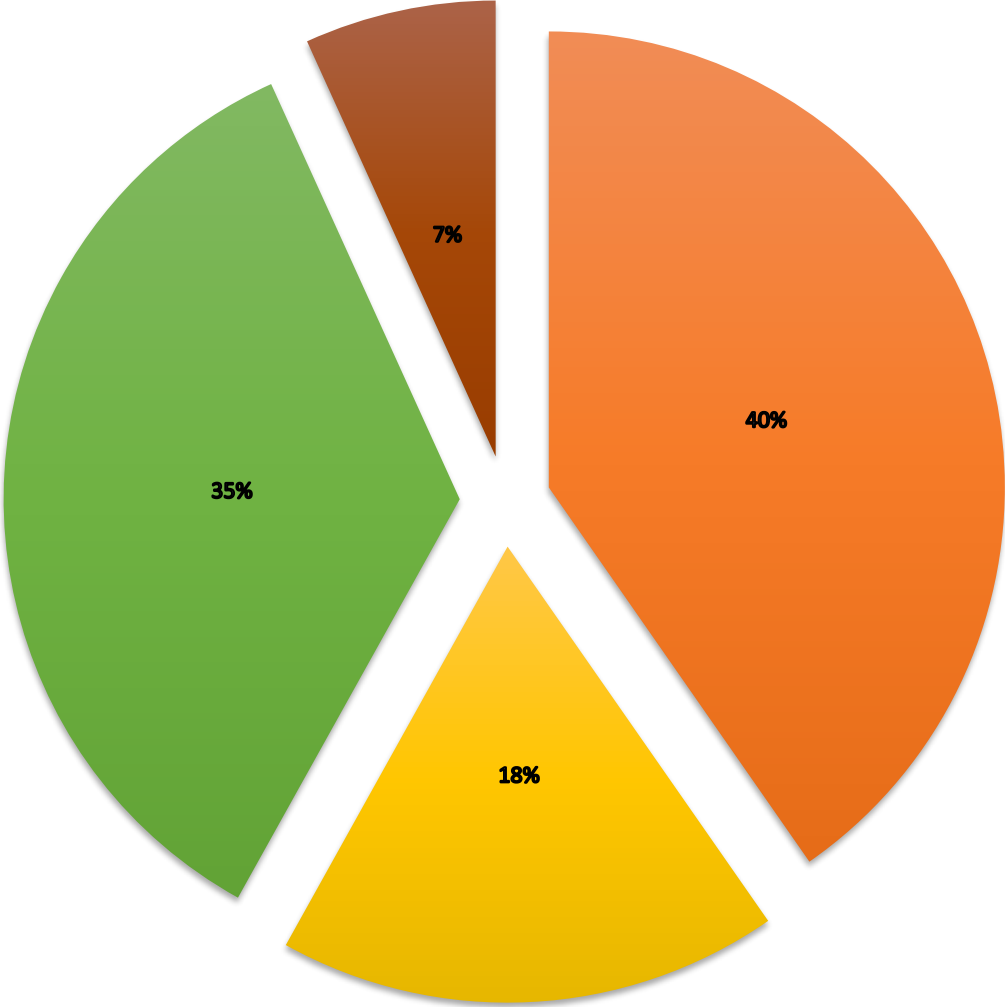
The terms of reference are those set out by Legal Aid and used for data collection purposes i.e. gender, ethnicity, disability, age and outcomes.

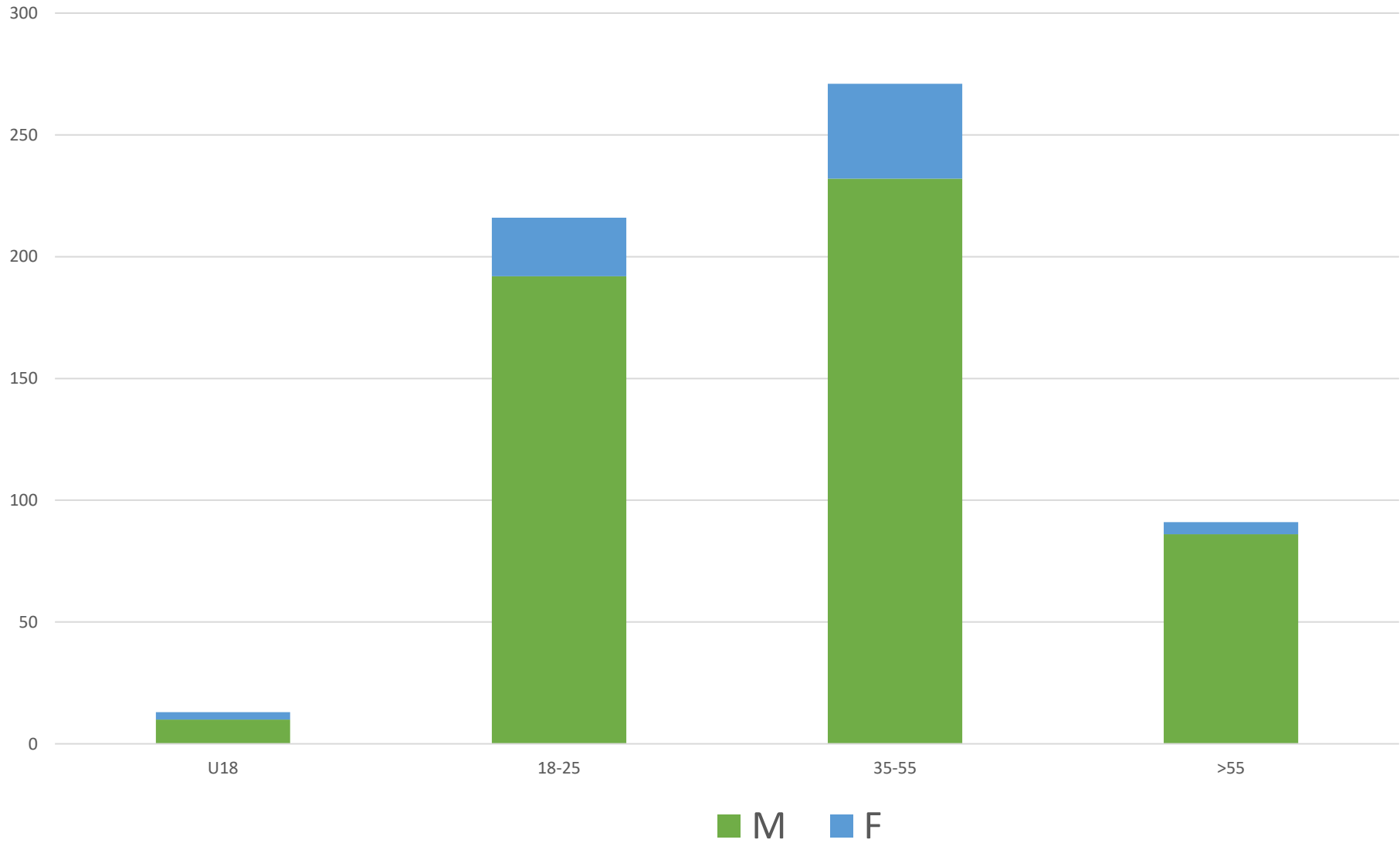

3. **Number of clients by ethnicity and gender.** This provides an overview of clients across all areas of law based on their ethnicity and gender as they identify themselves.
4. **Percentage of clients by disability.** This provides an overview of clients across all areas of law based on disability as they identify themselves.
5. **Outcomes by ethnicity for asylum and immigration matters.** This shows the breakdown of asylum and immigration matter outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by ethnicity.
6. **Outcomes by ethnicity for other civil matters.** This shows the breakdown of other civil matter (i.e. public law, community care, claims against public bodies, discrimination) outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by ethnicity.
7. **Outcomes by gender for immigration and asylum matters.** This shows the breakdown of asylum and immigration matter outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by gender.
8. **Outcomes by gender for other civil matters.** This shows the breakdown of other civil matter (i.e. public law, community care, claims against public bodies, discrimination) outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by gender.
9. **Outcomes by ethnicity in criminal matters.** This shows the breakdown of criminal matter outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by ethnicity.
10. **Outcomes by gender in criminal matters.** This shows the breakdown of criminal matter outcomes (i.e. positive, negative, neutral or unknown), by gender.

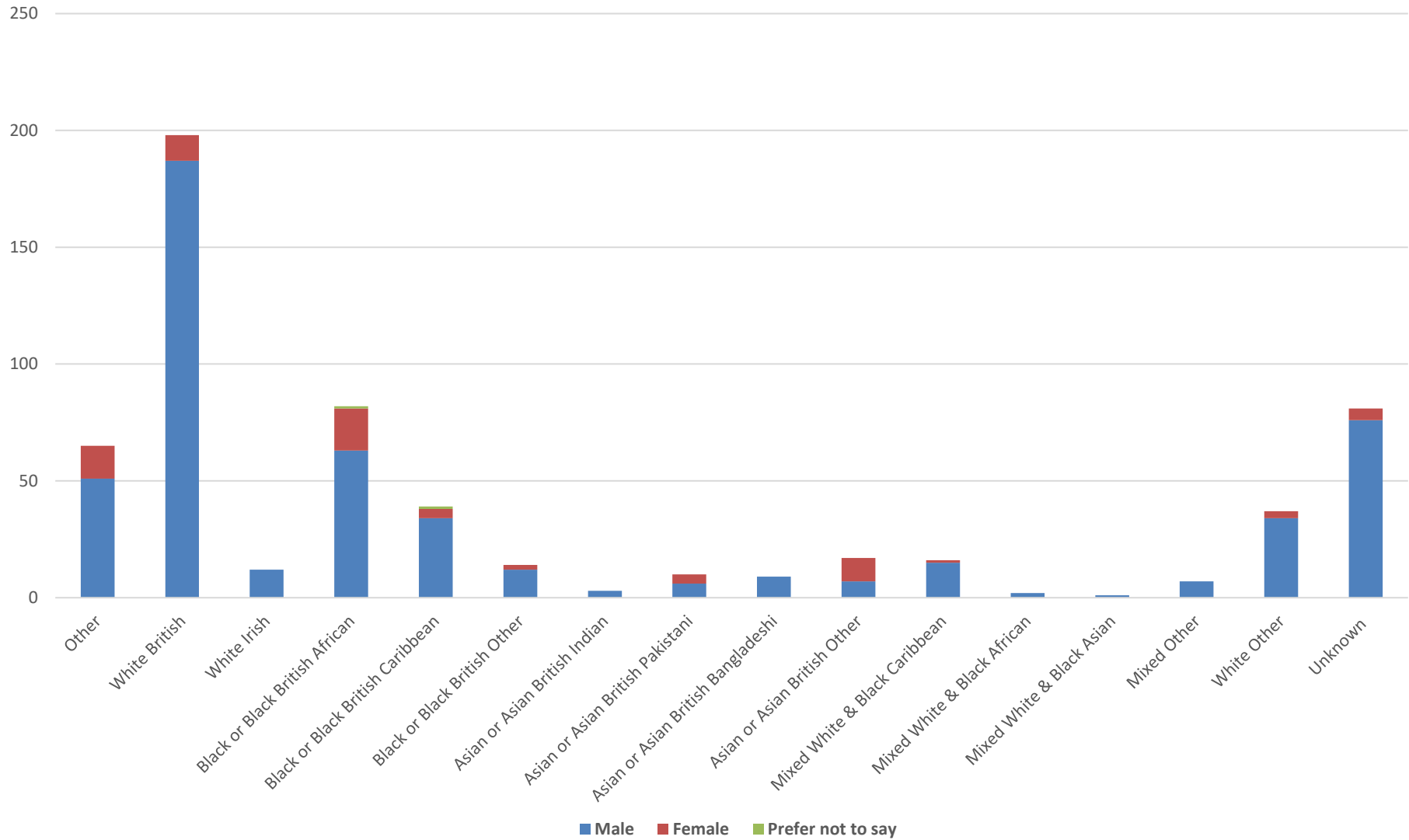

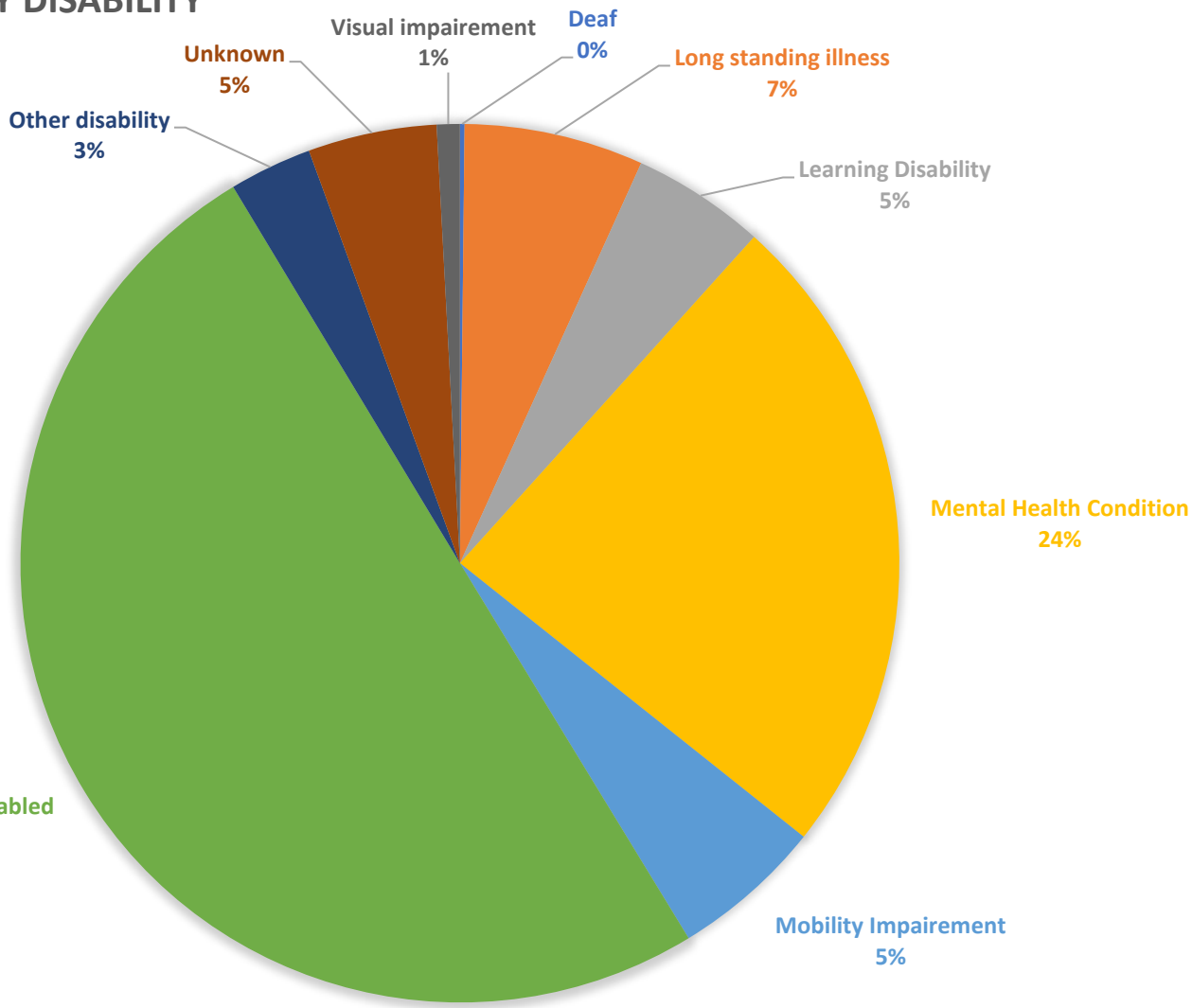
Number of clients by age and gender



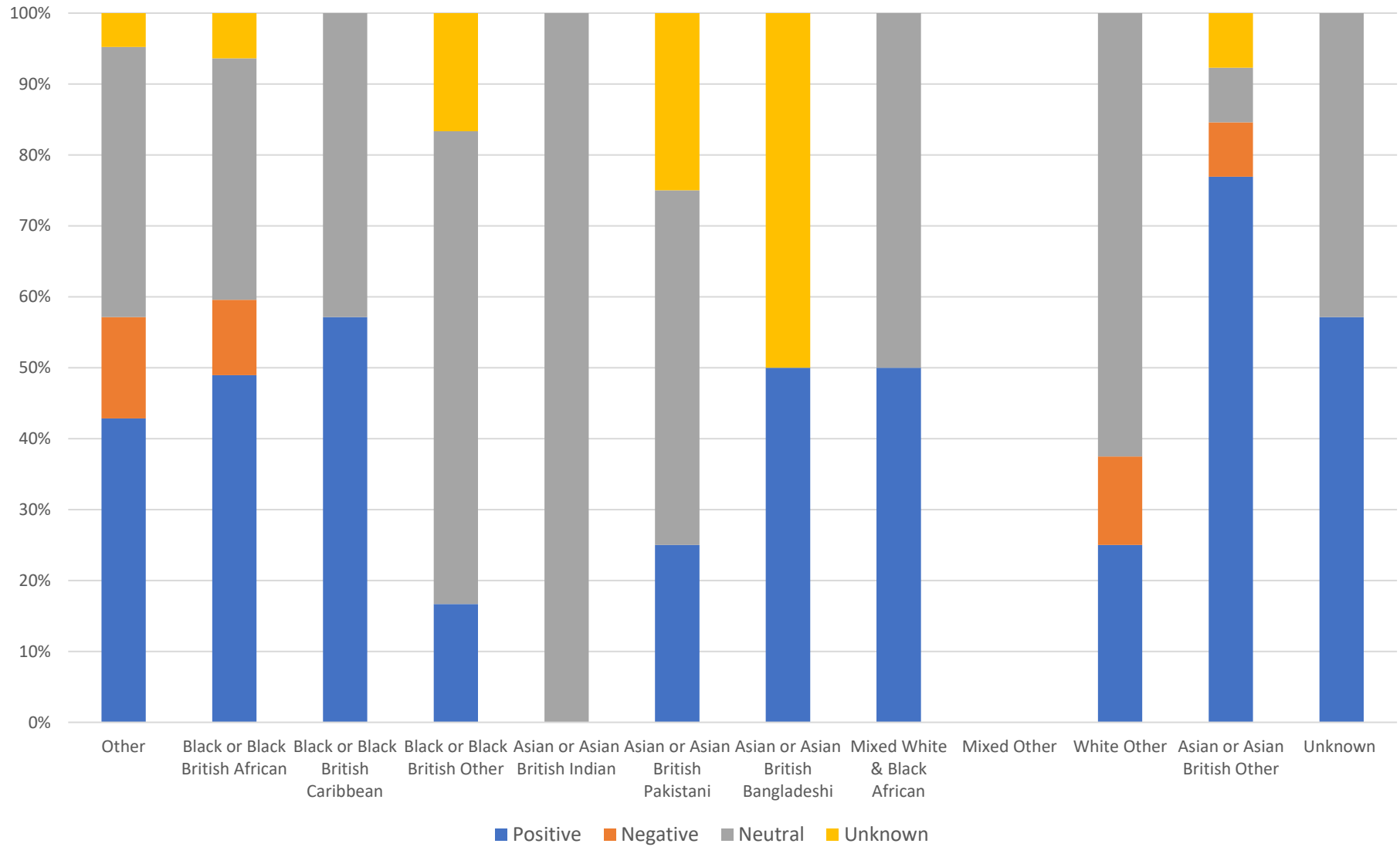
## Number of clients by ethnicity and gender



# % OF CLIENTS BY DISABILITY

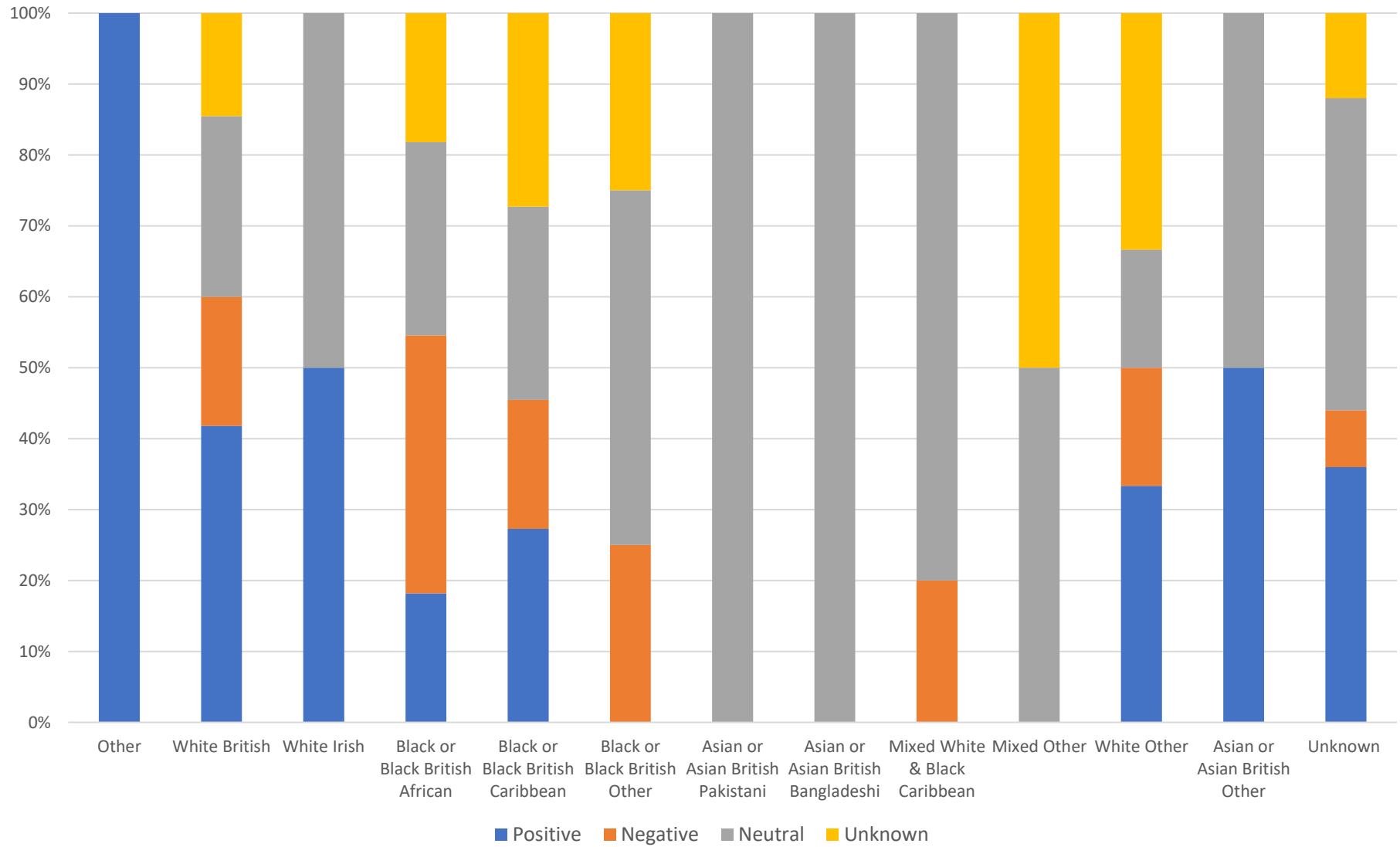


Outcomes by ethnicity for Asylum & Immigration matters

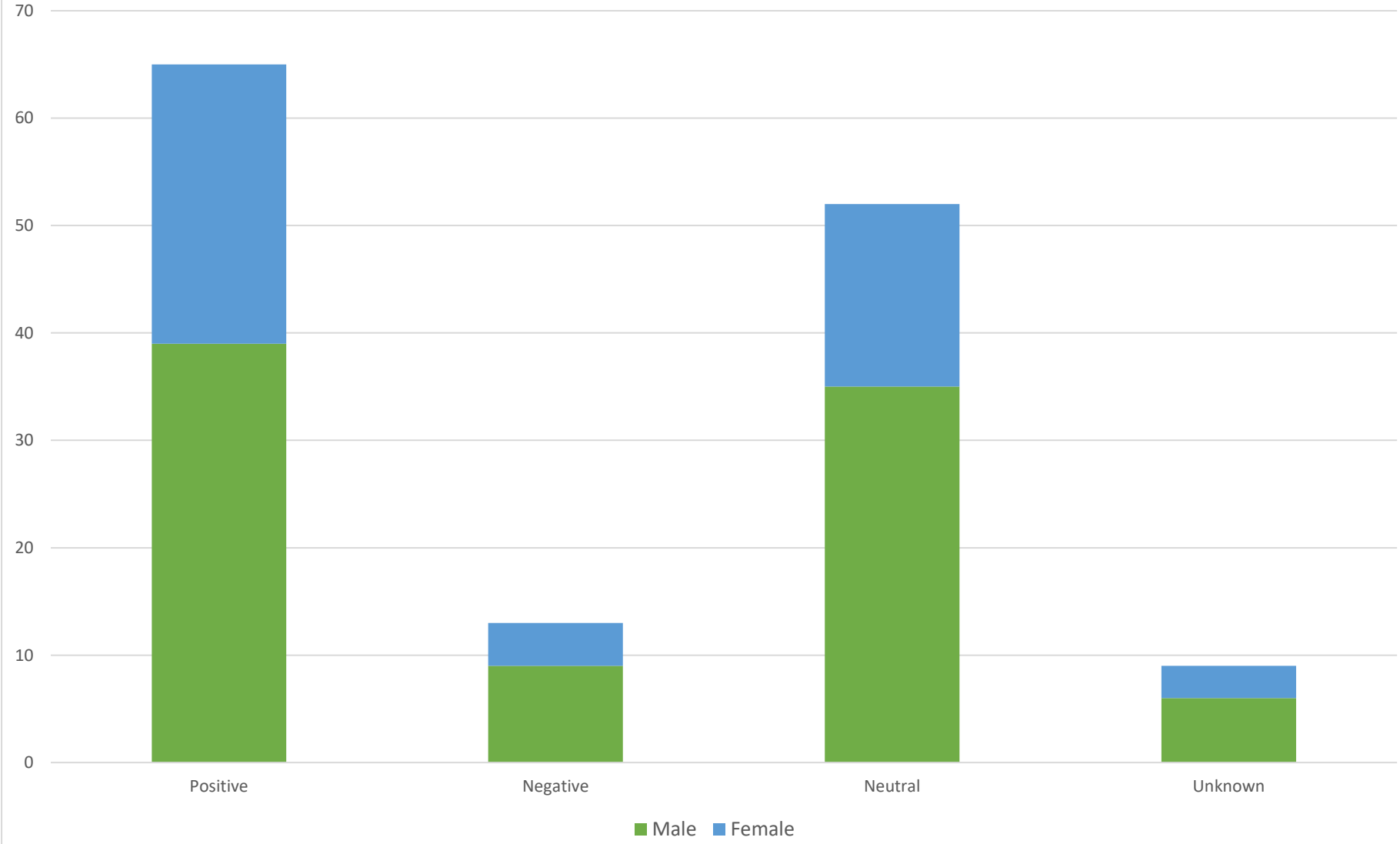




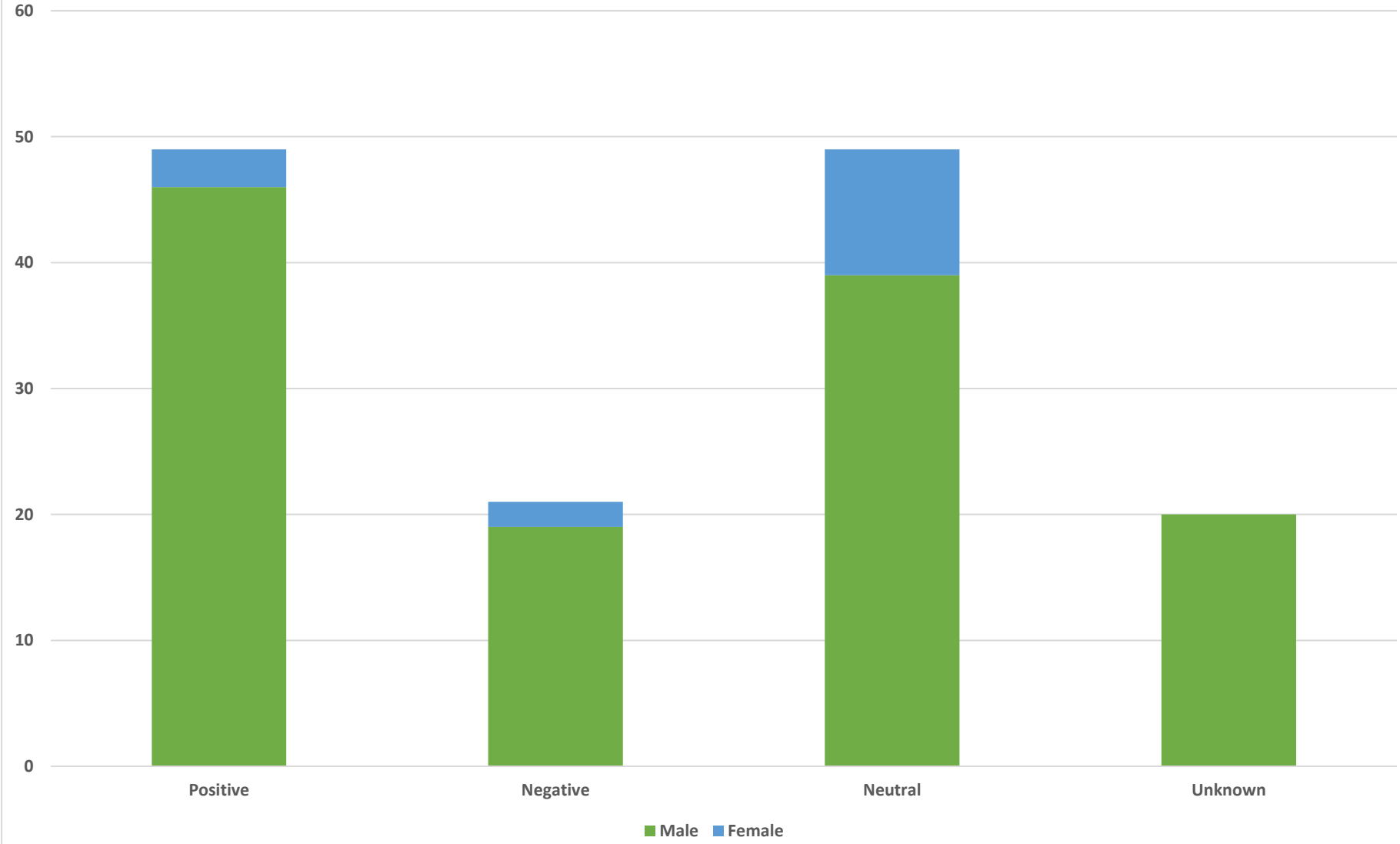
Outcomes by ethnicity for other civil matters



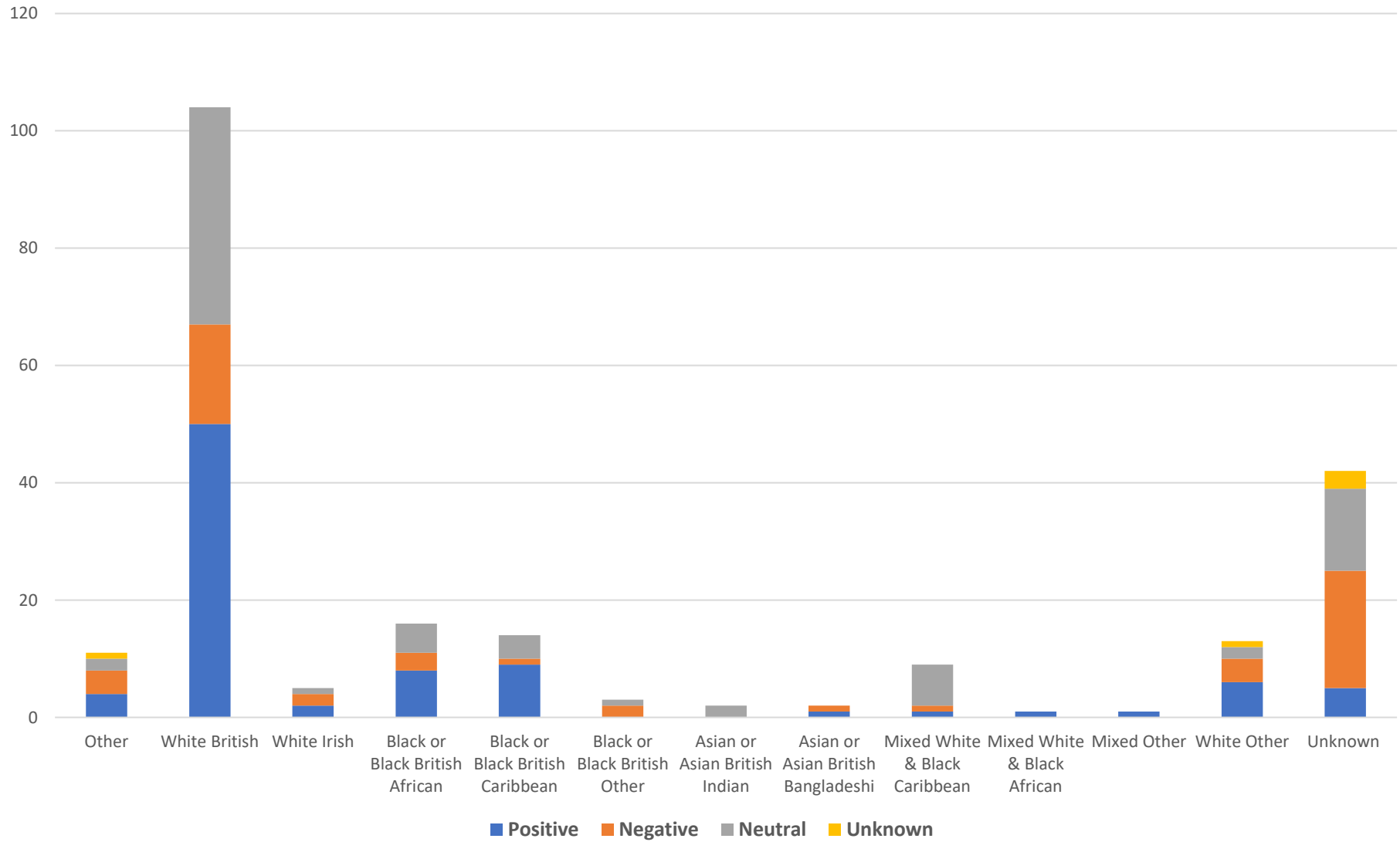
Outcomes by gender for Immigration & Asylum matters
